- Experienced – pros/cons




- Inexperienced – pros/cons

 General Consideration 1. Understanding Plaintiff's BOP: a. Testimony must be based on reasonable "probability" (not possibility). 2. Proving Causation: a. General

b. Specific



<u>Concessions</u>:
o Minor points are ok
o Major points can't happen



- Dealing with Additional Variables:

• Expert need time to evaluate additional variable that are not included in lawyer's questions.


- Knowledge of the records and/or facts of the case.
- Diffuse client problem areas
- Able to cite specific articles/studies to specific opinions
- Use of other experts to assist with expert education

 Cut-Off any angle that Defense may use:



- Do a Background Check of your Expert;
- Double-check Expert's credentials;
- Review prior reports / testimony in similar cases;
- Review prior reports / testimony in different cases;
- Make sure relied upon sources are not "cherry-picked"

Treating Physicians



Possibly the most important witness in your case!

Contacting Treating Physician

 Clearly communicate reason for meeting:

- Claims against "manufacturer" (only)

- Care and treatment from any physician not at issue
- Treater is in the best position to give guidance on merits of case

Treating Physician

Deposition: Develop this testimony for potential Settlement purposes

Trial: Highlight strong points of deposition testimony
